

Culturally Informed Responses to Survivors of Sexual Violence

SURVIVORS NEEDED FOR RESEARCH STUDY

Description

This study examines how emergency service providers, such as victim advocates and sexual assault forensic examiners, support survivors of sexual violence, particularly marginalized and minority survivors, during crises.

Eligibility

- Experienced sexual violence* at least once in your lifetime
- Experienced sexual violence as an adult (age 16 and up)
- Must have access to a phone or computer with Internet for a 60-minute interview
- At least 18 years of age
- Black, Indigenous, and People of Color are especially encouraged to participate

Time Commitment

- 3-minute screening questionnaire
- 60-minute remote interview, scheduled at your convenience

Additional Information

- Participants will not be compensated.
- Your personal information will remain confidential, accessible to only the principal investigator and her faculty supervisor
