# LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING AND RESEARCH

## REQUIREMENTS

---

- Must be 18 years old or older.
- Must have reliable transportation.
- No history of or reports of domestic violence, sexual assault, or other violent and/or sexually explicit crimes filed against you.
- Must be able to work in a team environment.
- Must be able to operate Microsoft Office programs, social media platforms, and video conferencing programs such as Zoom.
- Must be able to commit to a minimum of 8 hours a month.

## FUNCTIONS

---

- Assist or lead research projects to better law enforcement training.
- Assist or lead in research, projects, and meetings to better community understanding and involvement in responding to sexual violence.
- Assist or lead in survey analysis.
- Promote and schedule law enforcement and CoSAR trainings and meetings.
- Other similar duties as needed.

## OTHER INFORMATION

---

Due to COVID-19, interns may be able to work remotely rather than in the office. Internet access, email, and access to video conferencing is a must. Once a month a face to face meeting will be scheduled at the office (*located in North Little Rock*) if obtainable.

The Law Enforcement Training and Research Internship is a one year term. Interns may apply for additional intern opportunities each year. During that time any positions that become available at ACASA your services will be considered in the highest regard.
